Project Proposal Process

- Choose project from Brownsburg Parks list of **project priorities**. (Click Link)
- Written project proposal must be submitted to Brownsburg Parks before Scout turns 17.
- Project proposal must include the following items:
 - Contact information sheet
 - Eagle Scout Service Project Proposal
 - Project Proposal Questionnaire
- Brownsburg Parks will review the proposal to ensure it meets the needs of the department, is consistent with the strategic goals of the organization and follows all required criteria.
 - **NOTE:** This process may take up to 30 days.
- If project is chosen, Scout will meet with Operations team to discuss project expectations, timeline and fundraising expectations.
 - Project mentor/leader of Life Scout must be present for observation and sign-off purposes only.
- Once project is finalized and all documentation is provided to Brownsburg Parks, Operations staff will approve the project and timeline.
- Life Scout will present the project to the Brownsburg Park Board for approval.
 - **NOTE:** The Park Board meets on the third Thursday every month at 6:30 PM at the Town Hall Council Room.
- Operations team will work directly with Life Scout throughout the duration of the project.
- Life Scout is required to check-in with the Operations team monthly, by phone or in-person, to discuss the status of the project, any issues, delays or additional resources the scout needs, and identify solutions. Consistent communication of project is expected.
- Once the project is complete, Life Scout will present final project to the Brownsburg Park Board.
